

Update on 10 October 2017



The Police and Crime Commissioner Jason Ablewhite has been asking people how the fire service should be looked after in Cambridgeshire.



The consultation closed on 4 September 2017



2,427 people and organisations told us what they thought.

53%

53% of people who completed the survey agreed that the Police and Crime Commissioner should look after the Fire Service instead of the Fire Authority.



But Cambridgeshire County Council and Peterborough City Council do not agree.



The Police and Crime Commissioner has listened to people's views and concerns.

The report will be sent to the Home Secretary, Amber Rudd.



The Home Secretary will now decide whether the Police and Crime Commissioner can look after the fire service.
