Cambridgeshire Constabulary

Community Road Safety Problem Solving: Police Casualty Reduction Officer supporting educational and preventative road safety across Cambridgeshire and Peterborough.

£74,176

Community Speed Watch Co-ordinator: Supporting communities to participate in and lead educational and preventative road safety action. This included resources to enable letters to be sent to motorists seen speeding.

£64,010

Community vehicles for Special Constables: Running costs of the vehicles which enabled local special constables to contribute to the Vision Zero Partnership.

£3,538

Road Safety – Small Grants

Enhancing safety of people with communications needs: Seatbelt covers which highlight that the driver is a member of the Pegasus Scheme. These quickly signpost emergency services to further information about how to communicate effectively.

BikeSafe programme: Resources that enabled the promotion of the scheme which focussed on improving the safety of younger motorcycle riders who tend to be more at risk of road traffic incidents.
