5	East Cambs	Installation of CCTV at the Lighthouse Ely to act as a deterrent to ASB.	£4,668
6	East Cambs	Solar powered CCTV to be installed at Pauline's Swamp nature reserve in Burwell following recent ASB.	£2,957
7	Cambridge City	Installation of two refuge points in Market Square, Cambridge. These will provide a safe point of refuge in emergency situations. The user of the refuge point is able to speak directly to a CCTV control room operative via	£5,000

		intercom and can be seen via permanent CCTV cameras in the surrounding location.	
8	East Cambs	Purchase of bike marking kits to be used at events being held over the summer and at schools.	£3,032.50
9	Fenland	Removal of extremist graffiti in Wisbech.	£1,100
10	Fenland	Clearance of rubbish behind a recycling centre on New Drove, Wisbech, including cutting of trees and preparation of the area to be fenced off to prevent future fly tipping.	£4,500
11	Cambridgeshire Constabulary	Bike marking kits and a GPS system and SmartWater to prevent cycle theft in Peterborough.	£3,000
12	East Cambs	Design and production of posters, stickers and booklets for Shop Watch scheme in Ely and Soham to help to tackle shoplifting.	£1,349.50
13	South Cambs	A cycle safety session in Northstowe to carry out maintenance checks on bikes and to fit lights on bikes that don't already have them.	£662
14	East Cambs	Purchase of purse bells. RFDI protection folders and leaflets around how to avoid being a target of personal theft to be handed out to members of the public in Ely.	£290.30

20	Fenland	Removal of fly tipping and installation of bunds, to make future removal of fly tipping easier, at Coldham Bank. Installation of signs and an action day to inform residents how to dispose of waste.	£2,402
21	East Cambs	Production of stickers that can be placed on JCBs/Teleporters across Cambridgeshire to make vehicles stand out and to get members of the public to report any suspicious vehicles seen on the road or parked up in areas where they shouldn't be.	£708
