4	Lighthouse Ely	A woodwork project running during the summer holidays, providing an opportunity for young people to learn new skills. The project will be particularly supporting young people referred by the police and local authority.	£3,500	June 2023
5	East Cambs District Council	Funding towards three youth engagement events that are being held over the summer holidays in Littleport, Bottisham and Soham.	£3,500	June 2023

6	RAF Wyton Airplay	Funding towards a residential trip for 15 young people over the summer, particularly supporting young people of service personnel	£1,212.50	July 2023
7	Sandy Hill Community Project	A six-week programme of outdoor activities supporting neuro-diverse young people to engage in activities that will support positive mental health and wellbeing, giving transferable skills to young people and adults in the local and wider community.	£3,360	July 2023
8	Peterborough Music Hub	A school-based music making nurture group for young people identified by the school SENCO as being at risk of school exclusion. The project would be delivered over a school year in weekly music making sessions with up to six students in each term.	£3,492	July 2023
9	Haddenham Parish Council	Funding awarded to run a youth club in Haddenham for a trial period, if this is successful then local partners and organisations will work together to identify long term funding.	£3,500	July 2023
10	Peterborough Police Amateur Boxing Club	Funding towards venue hire, replacement ring canvas and an event being held by Peterborough Police Amateur Boxing Club whose primary aim to encourage disadvantaged youths who may be susceptible to criminal influence and offending away from the local streets and into a safe space.	£3,500	July 2023
11	RKA Kickboxing Academy	Funding for equipment for their Glove Up programme which works with young people who have found themselves in difficult situations and who need help in re-building themselves. having a focus and a change of direction.	£3,000	July 2023

12	Whittlesey Cricket Club	Funding towards new cricket nets and storage facilities to help facilitate cricket sessions for young people in Whittlesey.	£3,000	July 2023
13	J G Gill Next Generation CIC	Funding for two boxing programmes, one in March and the other in Wisbech, focussed on young people who are involve or at risk of becoming involved in criminal activity.	£3,495	September 2023
14	Stretham Youth Centre	Providing outreach worker support for six months to work with young people in the local community.	£3,500	September 2023
15	Cambridgeshire Police Amateur Boxing Club	To enable the club to purchase a new collapsible boxing ring. The club is based in Huntingdon and supports many young people from the local community helping to prevent them becoming involved in ASB or criminal activity.	£3,000	September 2023
16	Wisbech Housing Related Support	Funding for a weekly programme of gym sessions and support from K9, who use dogs as a form of well-being support. The programme aims to tackle the physical and mental health issues of the young people accessing the service, whilst also allowing them to build positive relationships within the cohort and with external providers.	£3,000	December 2023
17	Soham Town Council	To hire the Connections bus to offer young people the opportunity to engage in an outreach capacity and develop relationships rather than being bored and tempted into risk taking behaviours, drugs, alcohol and boredom related low level crime.	£3,500	December 2023

18	Community First Peterborough	Funding towards their youth club in the Millfield/Gladstone area of Peterborough. Including funding towards a launch event, new equipment and excursions for the young people.	£3,500	December 2023
19	The K9 project	To run groups for isolated and at risk young people to help develop their communication and life skills, using dogs as a way to support the young people and help break down barriers.	£1,646	January 2024
20	PARCA	To provide new equipment and refreshments for a youth club in Peterborough that supports young people and creates a safe space for those from refugee, Eu citizen and others communities.	£3,500	February 2024
21	SIN Cru	Funding towards creating a sustainable eco-build community building in the Arbury area of Cambridge. The project will involve young people in the creation of the building and provides creative workshops for the young people.	£3,494	February 2024
22	Phoenix Youth Provision	Funding towards a youth group for young people in Whittlesey who are isolated and staying within their own little communities. They consist of marginalised groups such as LGBTQ plus, children from non-English, backgrounds and young carers.	£3,500	March 2024
