<p><b>Cambridgeshire Constabulary</b></p>	<p><b>VAWG and Stalking Perpetrator Panels Resource:</b> Supporting the co-ordination and running of multi-agency panels to manage high-risk perpetrators.</p> <p><b>Dedicated Stalking Police Officer:</b> To assess and manage the risk of perpetrators and sharing knowledge across the constabulary.</p>	<p>£20,000</p> <p>£72,000</p>
<p><b>Cambridgeshire County Council</b></p>	<p><b>Independent Domestic Violence Advisor (IDVA):</b> Emotional and practical support and risk-based safety planning to victims of domestic abuse.</p> <p><b>Independent Stalking Advocacy Caseworker (ISAC):</b> Emotional and practical support, safety planning and advocacy for victims of high-risk stalking. The post works as part of a multi-agency response to stalking cases. <p><b>Cambridgeshire &amp; Peterborough Foundation Trust</b></p>	<p><b>Consultant Counselling Psychologist and administrator support:</b> Assessing and managing the risk to victims of stalking and providing one to one interventions to perpetrators of stalking and indirect advice and guidance to professionals. This is part-funded by the Probation Service contributing £50,000.</p>	<p>£136,846</p>
<p><b>Probation Service</b></p>	<p><b>Delivery of Stepwise programme:</b> Delivery of the Stepwise domestic abuse perpetrator programme to 50 male perpetrators of medium-risk domestic abuse.</p>	<p>£30,000</p>
