TITLE: APPROACH TO THE COMMISSIONER'S ANNUAL REPORT 2025-2026

1. Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this report is to share with the Police Accountability Board ("the Board") the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner's ("OPCC") timeline for producing the Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report for 2025-2026 which reports progress against the priorities set in the Police and Crime Plans which cover that period.

2. Recommendation

2.1 The Board is recommended to note the contents of this paper.

3. The Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report 2025-2026

3.1 The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 places a responsibility on police and crime commissioners to publish an Annual Report which shows progress made against Police and Crime Plans.

- 3.2 The Delivery Plan framework forms the basis of the content of the Annual Report which retains its previous ‘bullet point style’, rather than lengthy narratives – a move previously supported by Panel members. The production of the Commissioner’s Annual Report for 2025-2026 has therefore been drafted using the Delivery Plan Update Reports of [September 2025](#) and [March 2026](#), both of which were shared with Police and Crime Panel members.
- 3.3 The OPCC team are working towards an internal deadline of 1st June with a draft copy sent to the Chief Constable. The final draft – updated with performance data from today’s meeting (27th May 2026) will be presented to the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Police and Crime Panel on 13th July for members to make recommendations before signing off for publication.
- 3.4 Performance data from today’s meeting will be included.
