<b>Decision</b>	Appointment of Chief Finance Officer (CFO)
<b>Decision Summary</b>	<p>The Chief Executive of the OPCC and the current OPCC Chief Finance Officer have discussed the current operating model, whereby the CFO is also the full time Deputy Chief Executive of Cambridgeshire Fire and Rescue Service. They have determined that a part-time CFO post would be a more sustainable solution and the Commissioner has agreed.</p> <p>A national job advertisement was posted, and a transparent selection process then took place, which concluded with an interview panel. The panel determined that Philip Trussell met the selection criteria and was suitable for appointment into the role.</p> <p>The Police and Crime Panel held a confirmation hearing on Monday 6 November 2023 and recommended that Philip Trussell is accepted for the position.</p>
<b>Recommendation</b>	The Commissioner to sign the decision notice for the appointment of the CFO.
