Subject	<p>Countywide rape and sexual violence support service.</p> <p>Extension of contract to Cambridge and Peterborough Rape Crisis Partnership (CAPRCP).</p>
Decision	<p>To formally sign the contract variation form which enables a one-year contract extension to be offered to CAPRCP to deliver the countywide rape and sexual violence support service in 2024/25.</p> <p>The OPCC funding streams were agreed at Commissioning and Grants on 11th December 2023.</p>
Decision Summary	<p>CAPRCP were awarded the countywide rape and sexual violence support service contract in 2020. This includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• an all age countywide Independent Sexual Violence Adviser (ISVA) service; and• countywide emotional and practical support. <p>The contract was initially awarded on a two-year basis with the option of three additional years. This contract extension will be the final 'plus one' of the contract.</p> <p>The contract value for 2024/25 is £1.1million, this is made up of the following funding streams:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Core Ministry of Justice Victim Services Grant• Additional 'bid for' Home Office ISVA funding• Ministry of Justice Domestic Abuse/Sexual Violence Community Services funds

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Home Office Serious Violence Funding • Local Public health contributions – Peterborough & Cambridgeshire • Devolved Home Office Rape and Sexual Abuse Fund (RASAF) <p>CAPRCP provide support to any victim of sexual violence regardless of when the crime took place and whether or not the crime was reported to the police.</p>
Recommendation	Recommendation for the Commissioner is to formally approve the one-year contract extension.
