Decision	Approve the award of a contract to Phoenix Software Limited
Decision Summary	<p>The procurement of the IT Licensing Partner is designed to deliver better value for money on contract licence renewals across the region in a more effective and efficient manner.</p> <p>This new strategic contract will enable all renewals to be procured via a single partner who will be able to take a holistic view, aggregating or consolidating licences wherever possible to get the best deals.</p> <p>The contract to Phoenix Software Limited is for an initial term of four years from 16 January 2024 to 15 January 2028, with the option to extend for a further year.</p> <p>The estimated value of this contract over the maximum five-year period is in the range of £80-120m for the whole region.</p>
