Decision	Sign the contract extension for Embrace CVOC
Decision Summary	<p>Overview</p> <p>A tender was undertaken to secure a provider for the delivery of a Countywide Support Service for Young Victims and Witnesses of Crime in 2022. A three-year contract was awarded to Embrace CVOC starting on 1 July 2022 with the option for two further extensions of 12 months.</p> <p>The initial contract term expires on 30 June 2025 and the first extension has been invoked to commence 1 July 2025 until 31 March 2026 to bring it in line with the financial year. The nine-month extension value is £51,628.50 bringing the total contract value in 2025/26 to £68,838.</p>
Recommendation	Recommendation for the Commissioner is to sign the nine-month contract extension.
