

Home Office Funded Safer Streets 5 2023–25

Home Office Safer Streets 5 Fund – £820,000

Eighteen-month funding for initiatives to help deliver the following:

- Reduce neighbourhood crimes such as domestic burglary, robbery, theft from person and vehicle crime.
- Reduce Anti-Social Behaviour incidents (ASB).
- Change perceptions, attitudes, and behaviours towards Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG) and ASB in public places, with the long-term goal of reducing VAWG crimes and disorder.
- Improve feelings of safety for everyone, particularly women and girls, in public spaces and the Night-Time Economy.
