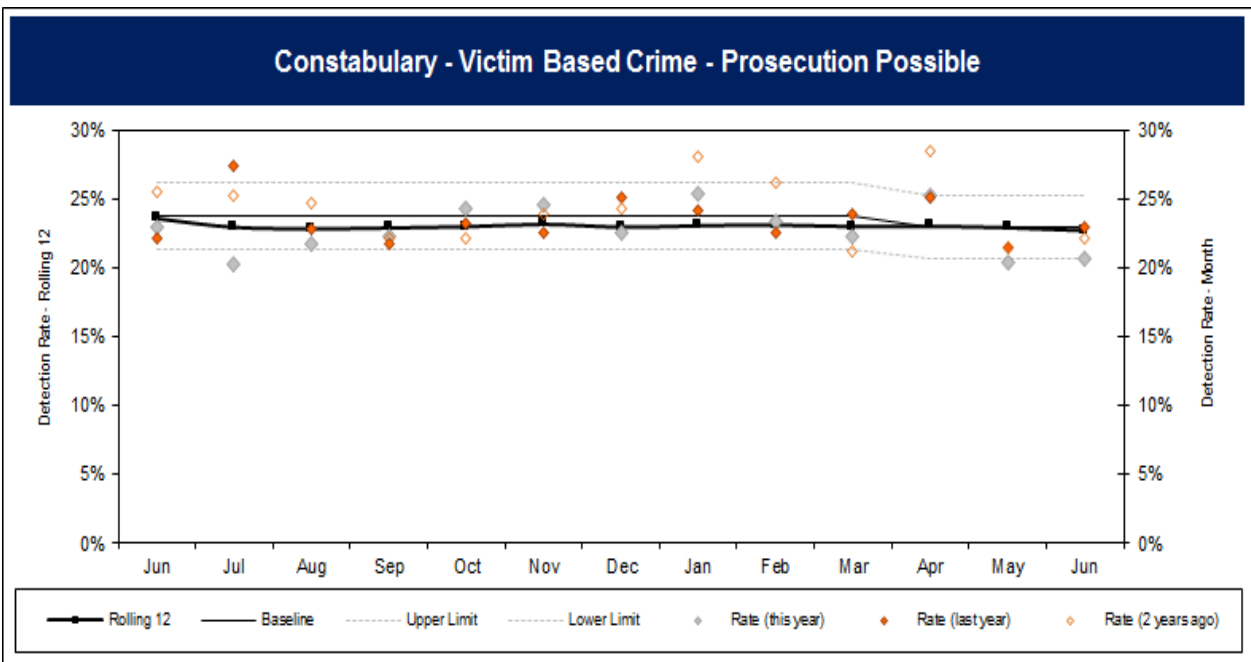
All Crime Detection Rate

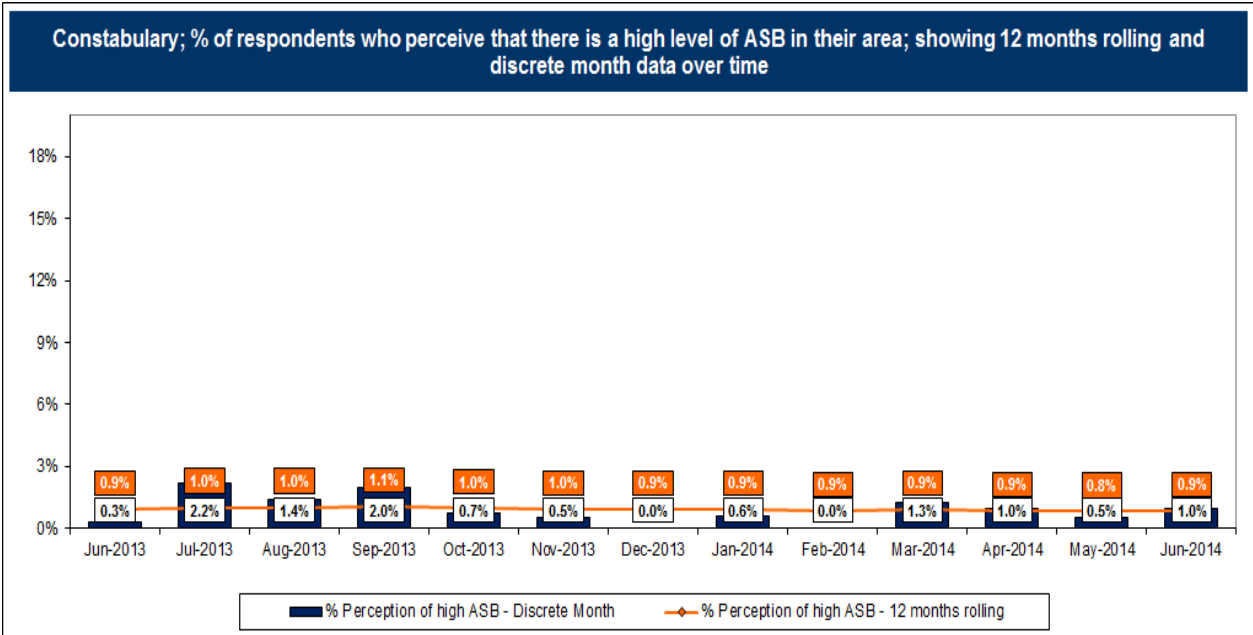


Victim-Based Crime Detection Rate				



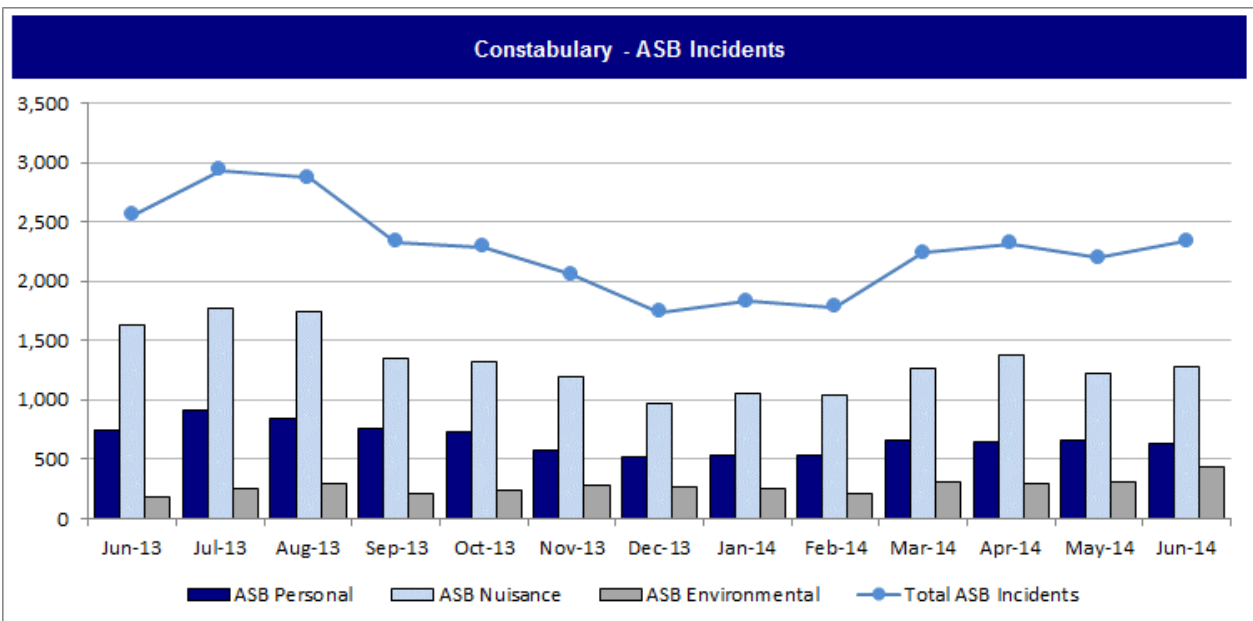

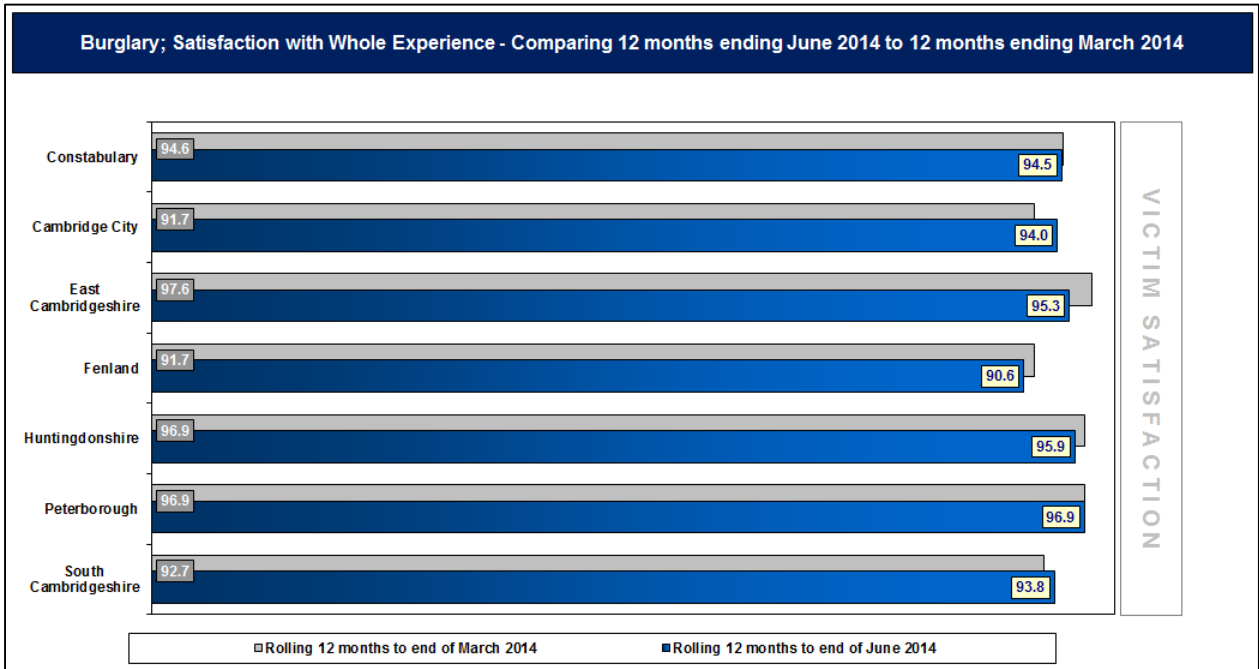

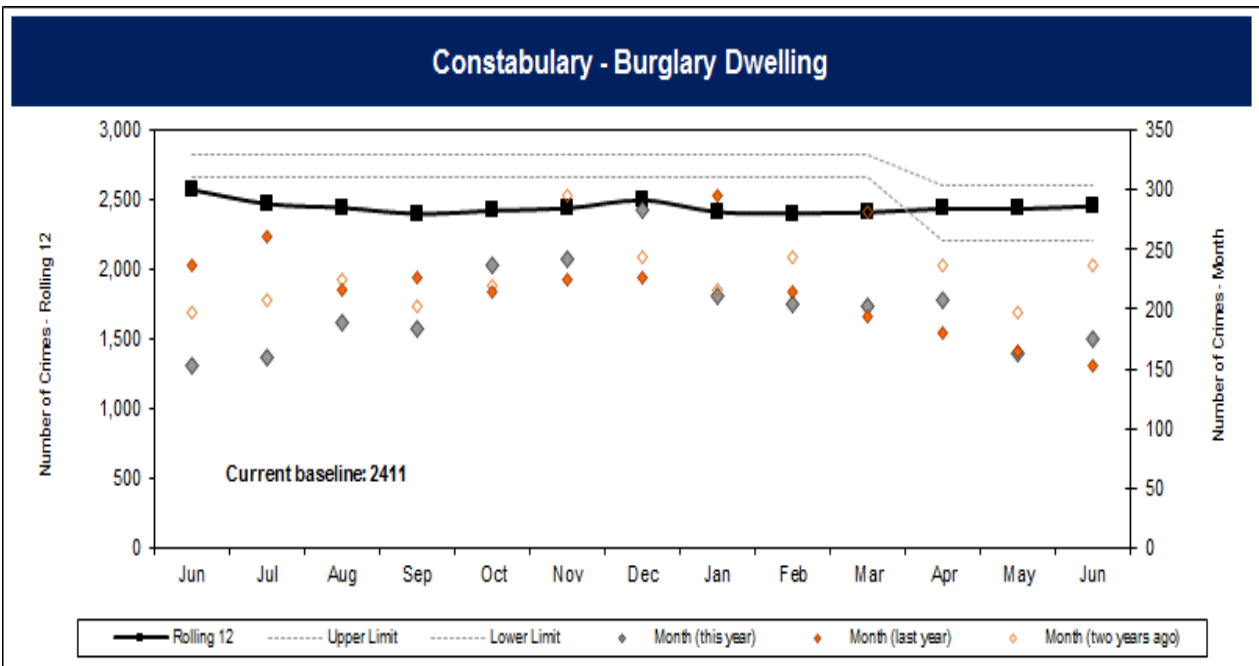


Satisfaction with Service Delivery - Burglary Dwelling

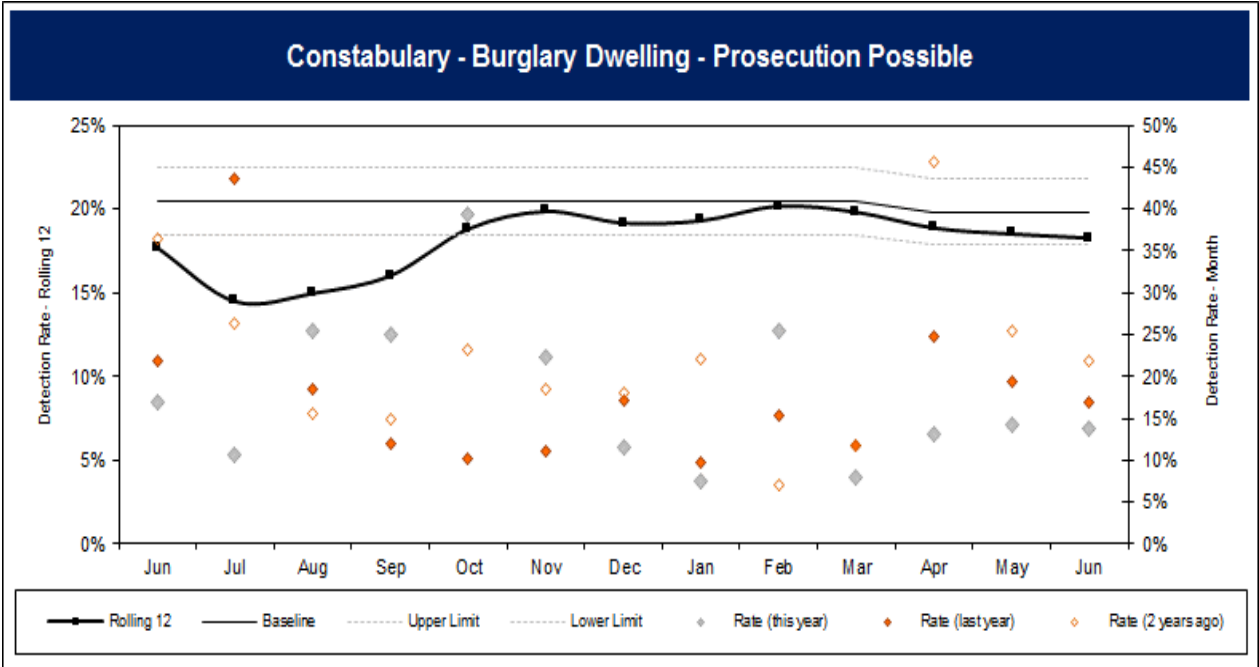

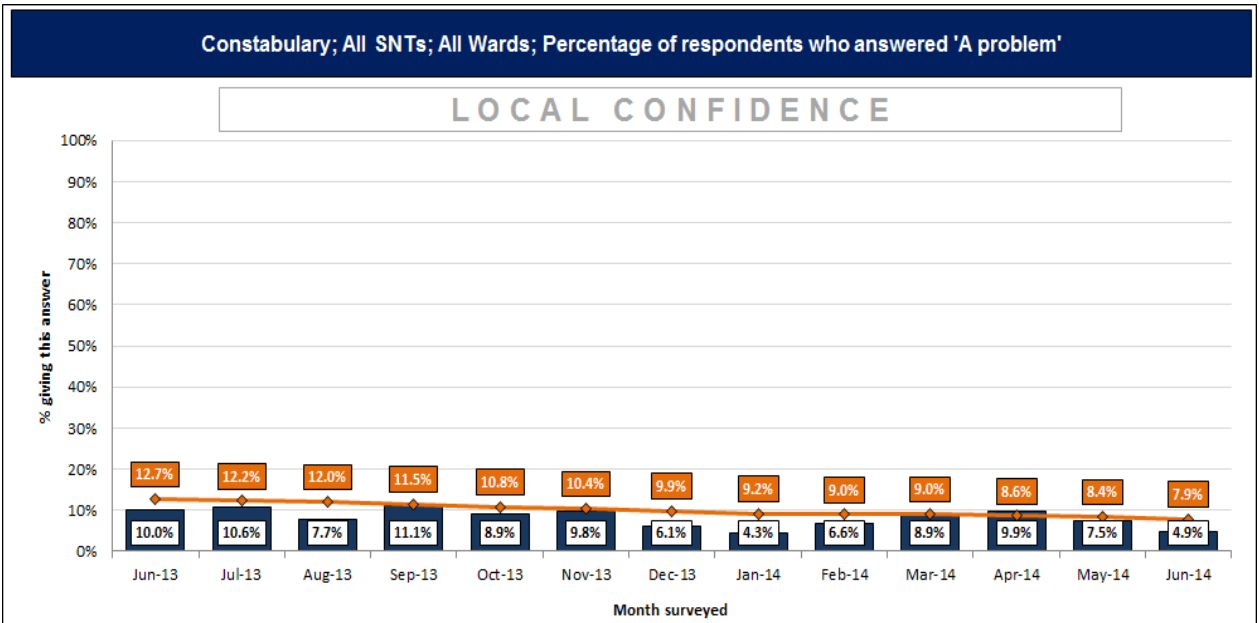

Burglary Dwelling Detection Rate			



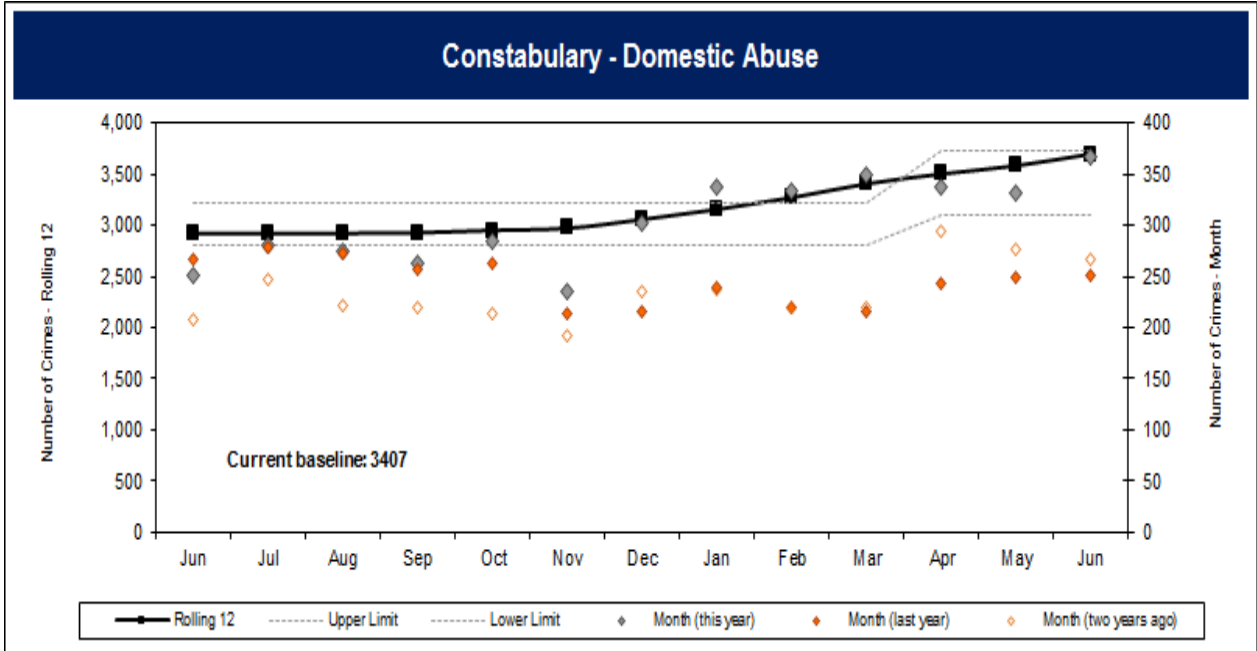
