Under freedom of information are Cambridgeshire Police aware that a birth certificate is not to be used for identification.

Why do Cambridgeshire police officers ask for date of birth when trying to identify members of the public instead of asking for the date they were born.

3

Are Cambridgeshire Police Officers/Constables aware of case history in relation to the birth certificate being used as identification.

4

Is Cambridgeshire Police and Crime Commissioner, aware of the legal name fraud in relation to the above questions.

In relation to questions 1-3, these relate to Cambridgeshire Constabulary, we have previously advised you of how to contact them.

In relation to question 4, this is not a request for information in the context of the Freedom of Information Act.
