On 7th February 2019 you requested the following information:

(Data for the periods 2017, 2018 & 2019 (to present day))

Data related to the number of times and dates (If recorded) of police checking the speed of bus drivers (using calibrated equipment) along the Cambridge busway (specifically the busway that runs from Trumpington to Cambridge South Train station).

If possible, I would also request that data related to the speeds recorded whether that be actual speeds taken or simply the number of speeding bus drivers caught while police were checking.

I can advise that the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does not hold the information requested. However, Cambridgeshire Constabulary, which is a separate organisation and is treated as such under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, may hold this information.
