I am writing in response to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August.

You asked how many reports/accusations of sexual assault have Cambridgeshire police received where by the accused/perpetrator was described as Minicab, Private Hire, Uber or a taxi driver, in the last 3 full years (figures separated by year/reporting period).

I can advise that the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does not hold the information requested.
