Dear Member of the Public

I am writing in response to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, dated 9th August 2018.

You requested information in relation to the cost to Cambridgeshire Constabulary in relation to policing far-right demonstrations and protests by organisations such as Britain First and EDL in calendar year 2017, including;

- mutual aid costs in our response
- how many such demonstrations our force has attended (including via mutual aid) since January 2013, broken down year by year (noting which were in purely mutual aid capacity)

I can advise that the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does not hold the information requested.

However, Cambridgeshire Constabulary, which is a separate organisation and is treated as such under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, may hold this information.
