Dear member of the public

The Police and Crime Commissioner is out of the office for the next few days so as not to delay matters I am responding on his behalf.

Further to your email below and following your correspondence, of the 2nd September, a colleague from the Crime Commissioners Office did contacted you on the 4th September to advice, that having passed on your correspondence to the constabulary the crime number provided by yourself was incorrect and asked that you provide the correct number. We have no record of you responding or providing the correct crime number. If you provide the correct number I will forward your email to Cambridgeshire constabulary?

Should you wish to make a complaint against an officer from Cambridgeshire Constabulary the Office of the Police and crime Commissioner are not the appropriate authority to consider such complaints. The appropriate authority to consider complaints against officers below the rank of the Chief Constable are the constabulary's Professional Standards Department (PSD). If you wish to make a complaint against a police officer, PSD contact details are as follows:

You have requested personal information ("*any related document and emails relating to this case*") under the Freedom of Information Act. The legislation says that organisations have to treat such requests under Data Protection legislation, and not the Freedom of Information Act, and that means that we have to confirm your identity before releasing such information. In order to provide you with any information the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) may hold, please provide photographic ID such as a driving licence so we can confirm your identity.

It is worth me pointing out before you go through this process that the OPCC, to which you have made this request, is a separate organisation to Cambridgeshire Constabulary. We do not have access to any of the data that the Constabulary holds for instance in respect of police intelligence, the Police National Computer, vehicle or crime intelligence. With regards to the FOI element of your request relating to your vehicle and case number, please contact, Cambridgeshire Constabulary, which is a separate organisation to the OPCC and is treated as such under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, they **may** hold some of this information.
